




Build Your Library

Build Your Library is a book-based curriculum that uses living books instead of textbooks to teach reading, writing, history, and science together. It's designed for families who love to read aloud and learn through stories. The lessons guide you through daily readings, narration, copywork, and hands-on projects that make learning feel natural and connected.

Curriculum Overview:

- Grade Levels:** Kindergarten through 12th grade
- Approach:** Literature-based and inspired by the Charlotte Mason philosophy – students learn through great books, narration, and discussion rather than worksheets and drills
- Subjects Included:** Reading, writing, vocabulary, grammar, spelling, science, and history woven together
