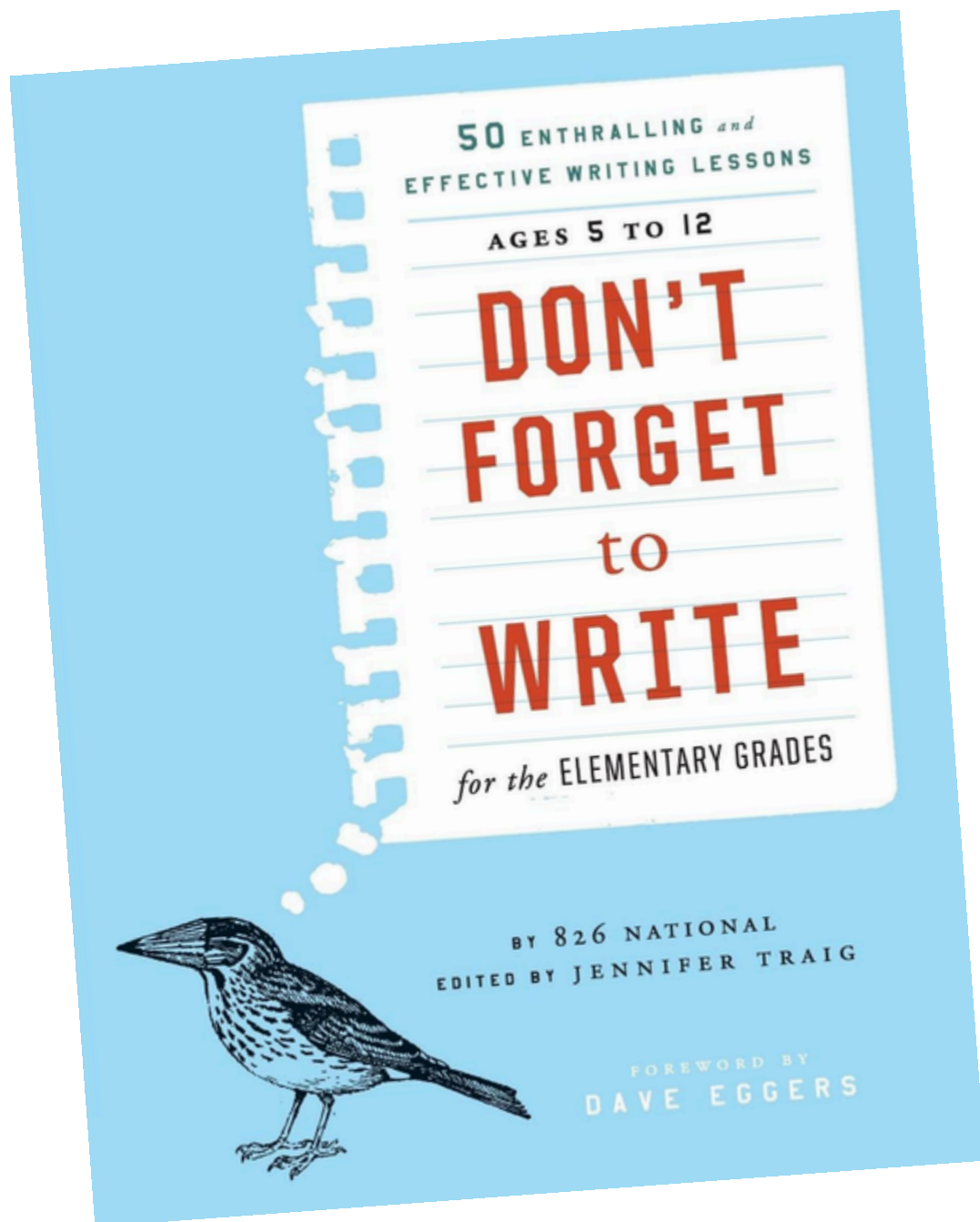


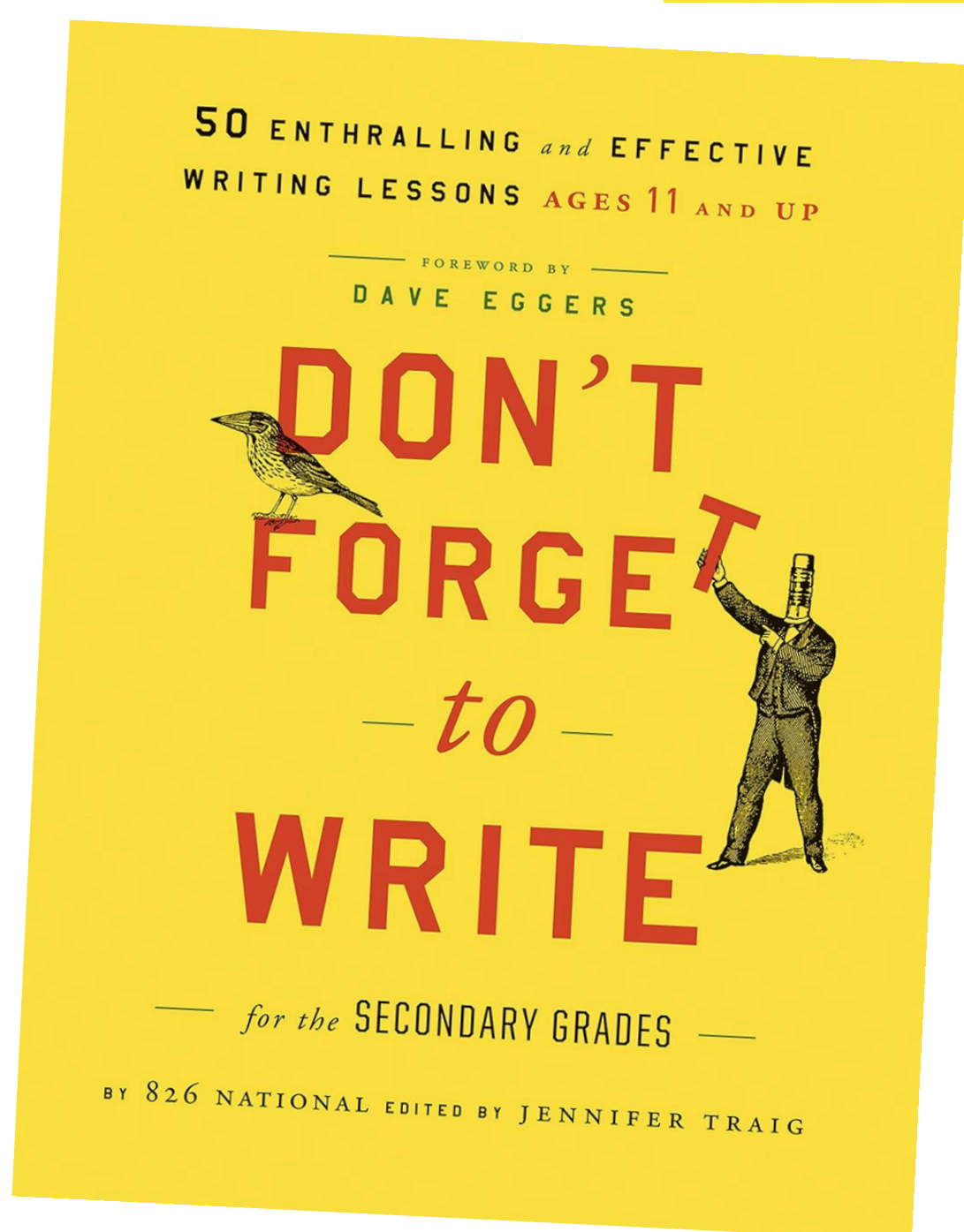

826 National is not a full ELA curriculum. It's a collection of ready-to-use writing lessons designed to help students start writing without getting stuck on grammar, structure, or perfection.

Lessons are short, engaging, and often a little quirky, which helps draw in students who are resistant or unsure about writing. Each lesson stands alone, so families can use them as needed—whether as a writing break, confidence boost, or supplement to another program.

Curriculum Snapshot

- **Ages:** Elementary (5–12) and Secondary (11+) options
- **Structure:** 50 stand-alone writing lessons per book
- **Approach:** Creative, discussion-based, low pressure
- **Prep:** Minimal – open-and-go style lessons
- **Focus:** Building voice, ideas, and writing confidence

This works especially well for students who feel stuck, overwhelmed, or resistant to writing. The flexible, pick-and-choose format makes it easy to plug into your week without adding pressure or a heavy workload.

Because it's not a full curriculum, it doesn't include ongoing grammar, spelling, or structured writing instruction. It's best used alongside another ELA program or as a way to get kids writing more consistently.
