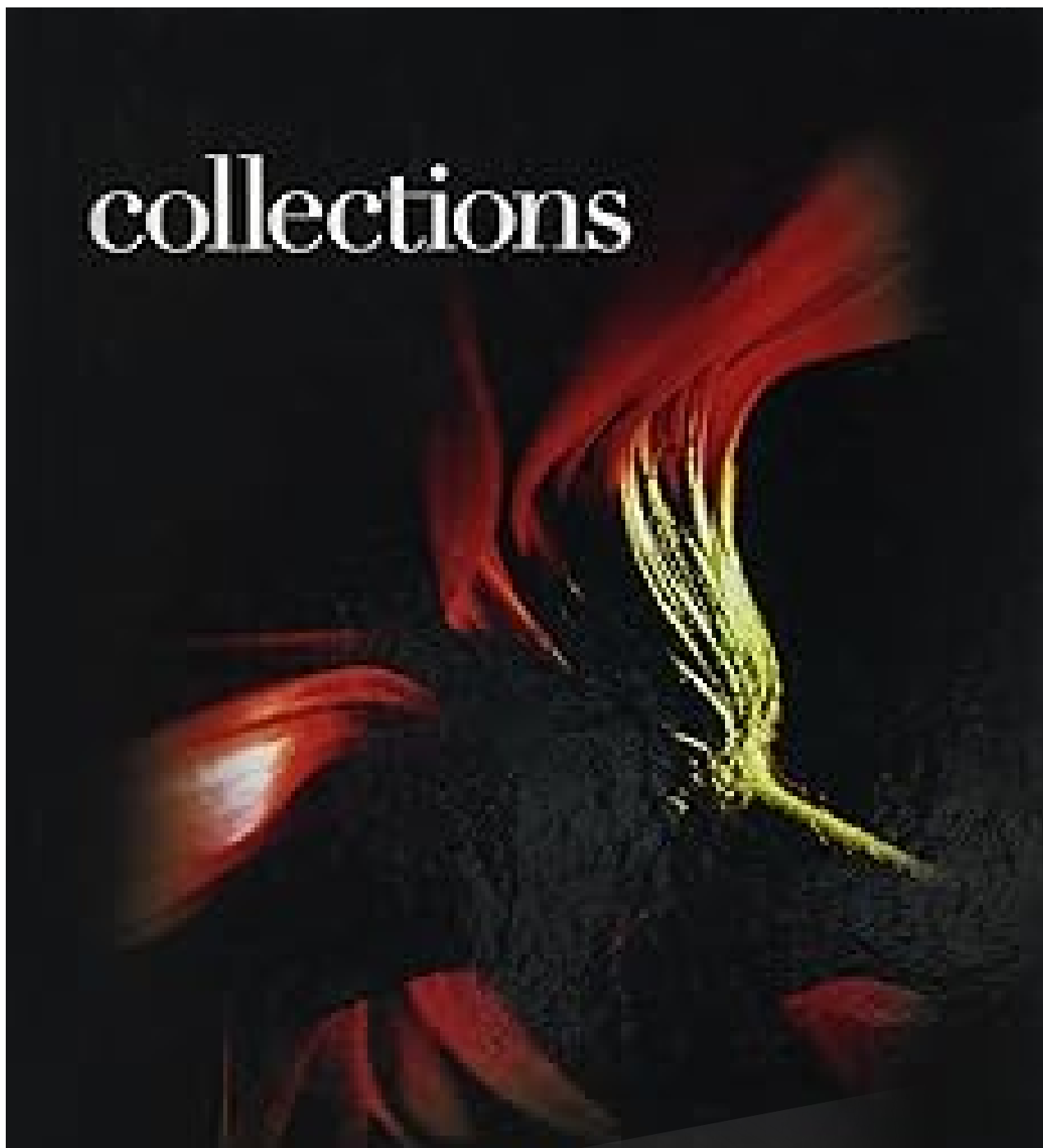


ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS



Rich literature and real-world connections that inspire critical thinking.

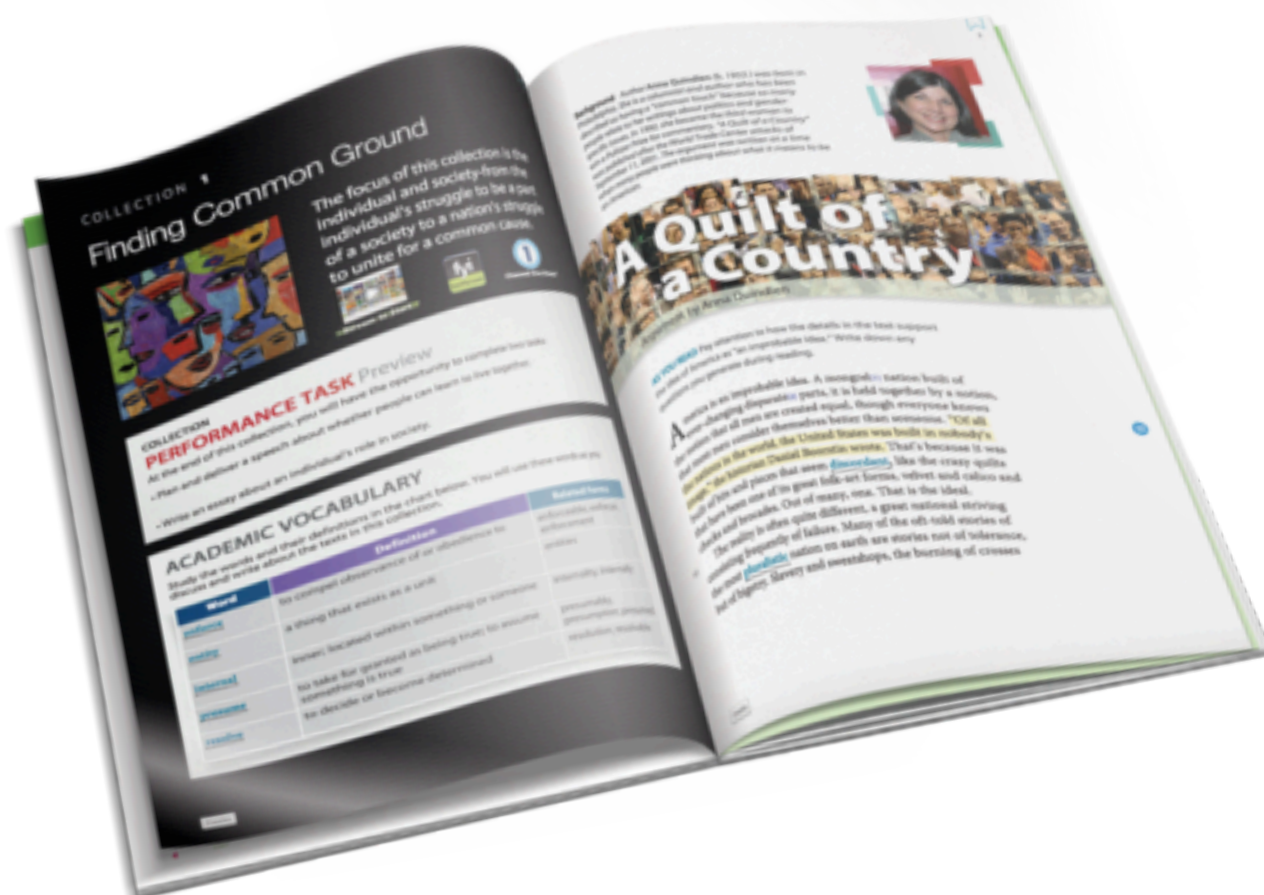
If your student enjoys variety in what they read and how they learn, Collections might be a good fit. It's a complete language arts program for middle and high school that blends literature, nonfiction, and plenty of opportunities to write, discuss, and think critically.

Each grade level has six themed "collections." Within each theme, students explore short stories, speeches, informational text, poetry, plays, and excerpts from novels. They compare different types of writing on the same topic, look at ideas from different perspectives, and respond through both speaking and writing.

Collections also offers digital tools and interactive activities, so students have multiple ways to connect with the material and show what they've learned.
