A structured approach to developing language arts skills, focusing on key areas like phonics, grammar, spelling, and literary analysis.

This program integrates literary study with writing mechanics, allowing students to develop a deep understanding of language in an engaging and interactive way.

Curriculum Overview:

- **Wand** covers phonics, spelling, grammar, punctuation, and vocabulary in three levels, each for a school year. Progressing sequentially is recommended as each level builds on the last.
- **Dart, Arrow, and Boomerang** are used alongside a monthly read-aloud. They focus on grammar, punctuation, literary style, and spelling through copywork and dictation. Dart is a year-long program, while Arrow and Boomerang can be purchased individually, with additional writing activities and discussion questions. Boomerang uses classic English novels for in-depth analysis.
- **Early English Literature Boomerangs** use classic English novels to inspire copywork, dictation, and Think Piece Questions, which delve into themes, characters, and plot analysis.

All guides are available as digital downloads, and while books must be purchased separately or borrowed from a library, this curriculum offers a flexible and comprehensive approach to language arts.
