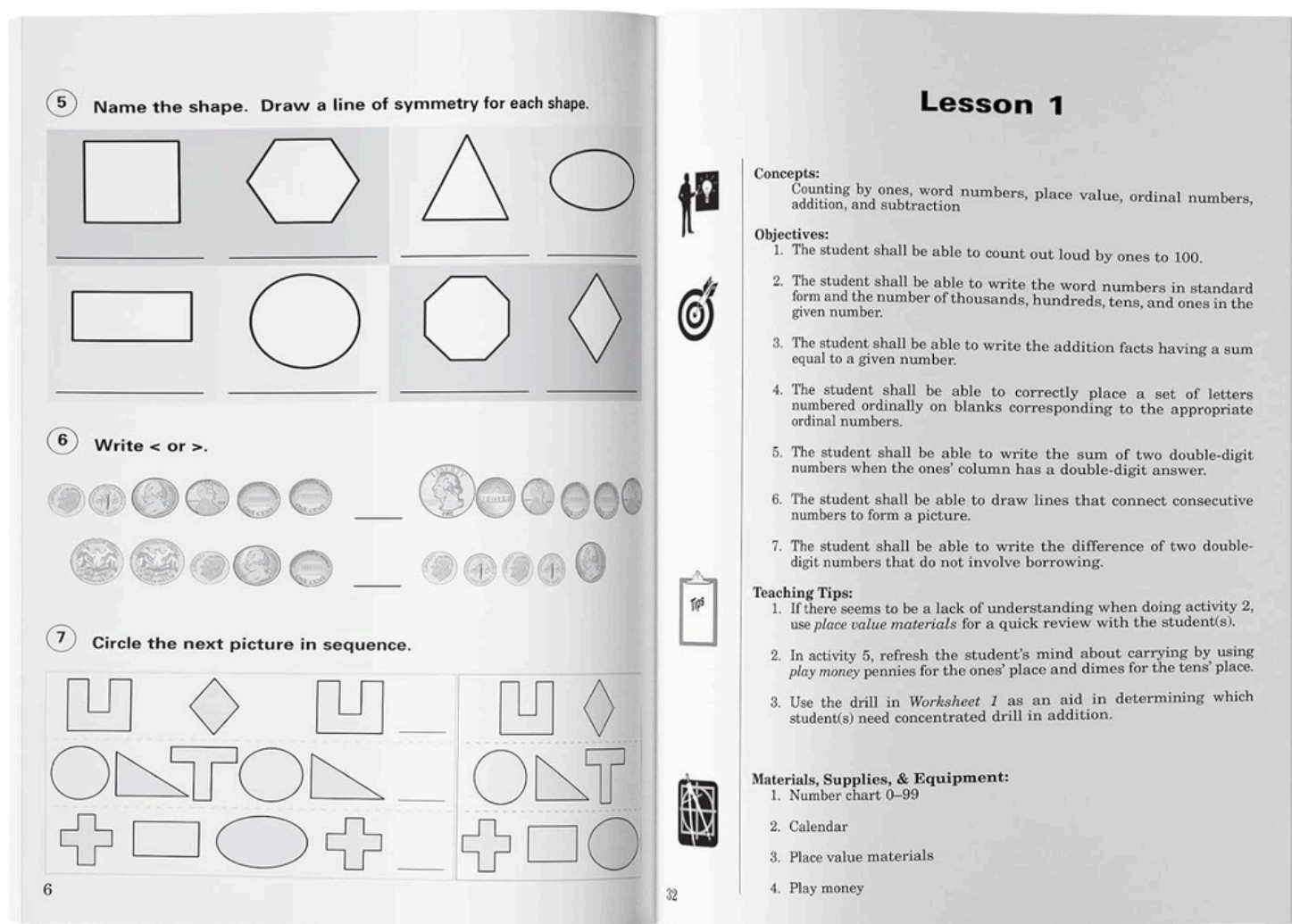


Teacher's Guide

The program moves steadily and includes frequent repetition, quizzes, and tests, which many families find helpful for building strong math skills and consistency.

Horizons works especially well for families who want clear structure, daily routines, and step-by-step guidance for teaching math. Because lessons are parent-led and fairly fast-paced, it may feel like a lot for students who struggle with focus, workbook fatigue, or who need a gentler, more independent approach.
