Spelling You See takes a different path from traditional spelling — no weekly tests or memorization of spelling rules. Instead, students gradually absorb word patterns through short daily lessons, copywork, and gentle dictation. Families tell us it often feels doable rather than overwhelming — but that it requires patience, especially early on. The gains aren't always dramatic at first; rather, they build over time.

Curriculum Overview

- Seven levels (A–G), skill-based rather than grade-based
- Daily lessons are short (about 10–20 minutes)
- Activities include copywork, chunking (color-coding letter patterns), dictation
- No weekly word lists or explicit rule memorization
- Open-and-go format — low prep for parents
- Emphasizes visual memory of letter-string patterns over rote drills
